- Eligibility:** Tournament is open to the public. Competitors must be members of the Louisiana Shooting Association (membership included in entry fee). Juniors are eligible but must have adult supervision. NRA classification systems will be used. Unclassified competitors will be placed in the Master Class, except those who hold an assigned classification under rule 19.6
- Rules:** Current NRA Small bore Rules will prevail. Rule 3.2 will be used.
- Fees:** NRA registration fee is \$ 8.00. Package fee is \$ 40.00; one day \$ 25.00. Package junior fee is \$ 25.00. One day junior fee is \$ 14.00. Make checks payable to Palo Alto Rifle & Pistol Club. Refunds made until one week before the match. Forfeited fees will be used to augment the awards schedule. Preference will be given to complete program entries.
- Time:** Firing will commence each day at 9:00 AM.
- Entry Limits:** Entries are limited to 40 competitors, the range capacity. Entries received beyond range capacity will be notified and put on a waiting list if desired.
- Challenges:** The fee shall be \$ 1.00 per challenge, returnable if upheld. All shots to be challenged within fifteen (15) minutes of the posting of scores.
- Scoring of Challenged Shots and Shots of Questionable Value:**
In this tournament, the plug type-scoring gauge will be restricted to use by range operating personnel, which will include the Range Officer, Statistical Director, Executive Officer and three members of the jury who will be picked prior to firing times.

Targets: Official NRA targets will be used (A-23, A-25, A-27). Shooters will mark and hang their own targets. Clips are required.
